

Subject : Scholarship Policy for the Academic Session 2026-27 onwards

The Scholarship in the form of a Tuition Fee Concession will be awarded to the Meritorious Students at the time of admission initially for the first year which can be extended in the subsequent years based on the student's performance in Semester/Annual examinations as mentioned in this policy. The policy will be applicable for all the programs across the University except Medical, Veterinary, Pharmacy, Physiotherapy and Ayurveda programs.

1. Undergraduate Programs :

The Scholarship in the form of Tuition Fee Concession will be admissible to the prospective students who are seeking admission in the Undergraduate programs on the basis of marks obtained in 12th (Best of five subjects with one subject [Physics, Mathematics, Chemistry/Computer Science/Electronics/Information Technology/Biology/Informatics Practices/Biotechnology/Agriculture/Engineering Graphics/Business Studies/Entrepreneurship] with English as one of the subject) from a recognized board as mentioned below :

2. Postgraduate Programs :

The Scholarship in the form of a Tuition Fee Concession will be admissible to the prospective students who are seeking admission in the Postgraduate programs on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination (Best of five subjects) from a recognized University/Institution as mentioned below :

(c)	≤70% to ≥80%	25%

3. Scholarship for Girl students

Prospective Girl students seeking admission in any program of the University will be awarded an additional 5% scholarship in the form of a Tuition Fee Concession, which is over and above the slabs mentioned above. Even, if any candidate does not fall in the above-mentioned slabs, he/she will be awarded a flat 5% scholarship in the form of a Tuition Fee Concession.

4. Scholarship for wards of Employees

Prospective students who are wards of the Employees of the University, seeking admission in any program of the University will be awarded an additional 5% scholarship in the form of Tuition Fee Concession, which is over and above the slabs mentioned above. Even, if any candidate does not fall in the above-mentioned slabs, he/she will be awarded a flat 5% scholarship in the form of a Tuition Fee Concession.

5. Sibling Scholarship

Prospective students who are siblings, seeking admission in any program of the University will be awarded an additional 5% scholarship in the form of Tuition Fee Concession, which is over and above the slabs mentioned above and will be awarded to anyone of siblings.

6. Scholarship for alumnus of Sanskaram Group of Schools

Prospective students who are alumnus of Sanskaram Group of Schools, seeking admission in any program of the University will be awarded an additional 10% scholarship in the form of Tuition Fee Concession, which is over and above the slabs mentioned above. Even, if any alumnus does not fall in the above-mentioned slabs, he/she will be awarded a flat 10% scholarship in the form of a Tuition Fee Concession.

7. Scholarship for wards of Defense Personnel

Prospective students who are wards of Defense Personnel seeking admission in any program of the University will be awarded an additional 5% scholarship in the form of a Tuition Fee Concession, which is over and above the slabs mentioned above. Even, if any candidate does not fall in the above-mentioned slabs, he/she will be awarded a flat 5% scholarship in the form of a Tuition Fee Concession.

8. Scholarship for J&K and Bihar area

Prospective students who are belonging to J&K and Bihar area seeking admission in any program of the University will be awarded an additional 10% scholarship in the form of a Tuition Fee Concession, which is over and above the slabs mentioned above. Even, if any candidate does not fall in the above-mentioned slabs, he/she will be awarded a flat 10% scholarship in the form of a Tuition Fee Concession.

9. Continuation in subsequent years

The scholarship in the form of Tuition Fee Concession awarded at the time of admission on merit basis will be awarded in subsequent years on the basis of performance in the semester/annual examination as the case may be and same will be paid in the form of Cheque in the name of student only.

For continuation of scholarship in subsequent years, the student shall have to meet the following conditions :

- (a) He/she should have scored 75% or above marks in aggregate with passing all subject in first attempt itself.
- (b) He/she should have 80% and above attendance in all the theory and practical subjects.
- (c) He/she must have cleared all the dues of the University.
- (d) He/she should not be receiving any scholarship from any other University/Institution/Department.
- (e) He/she is not involved in any act of indiscipline.

Note : The Scholarship Policy can be withdrawn or modified at any point of time with due approval of the competent authority of the University.
